Qur'an Young Reader and HIFZ Program Frequently Asked Questions

Q: In which class should I register my child?

A: If your child can read Qur'an fluently, then you can enroll in HIFZ class. Otherwise you should enroll in Qur'an reading class. Once graduating from reading class, child can be enrolled in HIFZ class upon teacher recommendation.

Q: Which Qur'an style will be used in HIFZ class?

A: We will support both Uthmani and Pakistani style Qur'ans. Student should bring the Qur'an of his/her own choice. Students should bring the same copy every day.

Q: How long will it take to memorize the whole Qur'an?

A: It is a self-paced program. Students can memorize typically a few lines to a page per day depending upon their capacity. More emphasis will be put on reviewing past lessons, so at the end we produce Quality Huffaz, who can recite fluently. Parents should always monitor their children's progress and talk to teachers regularly.

Q: Are there separate registration form for HIFZ and reading class?

A: Yes, fill out just one of them whichever is your choice of class.

Q: I need to register for only few days weekdays or only 1 day weekend. Can I get a discount?

A: Since you are using that spot in the class, you are responsible for full amount. We highly recommend attending all the days of the session to get maximum benefit i.A.

Q: I need 2 days weekdays and one day weekend (or some other mix and match) for Reading class.

A: You MUST choose one session. After a few weeks, based on the vacancy we can accommodate the additional days in different sessions. However this will be a privilege and can be changed if regular students need that spot.

Q: I can not pay tuition by bank account. Can I insted use credit card or cash?

A: No. Monthly tuition is payable by direct debit from bank account only.

Q: Can I pay for registration fee and books using cash or credit card instead of a check?

A: Cash is ok. No credit/debit cards.

Q: My child reads Quran good. He/She just wants to memorize. Can he/she still enroll?

A: Yes, certainly. Fill out the HIFZ registration form.

Q: Can I volunteer?

A: Yes, fill out the volunteer form. Only approved volunteers can be present in the class. Administration will notify volunteers of their duties/hours based on the need.

Q: Can I get discount in tuition if I volunteer?

A: No. All volunteer services are in-kind, for the sake of Allah s.w.t. only.

Q: My child is less than 5 years old, but well-behaved. Can you enroll?

A: No, we only accept 5 - 12 years age group now.

Q: What if I withdraw my children? Will you stop debiting tuition immediately?

A: A written notice is required to stop the payments. It will stop next month after such notice.

Q: What if I change my bank account?

A: Provide us new bank account information 30 days before closing current account.

Q: What if I do not have enough balance for a given month?

A: It is your responsibility to ensure enough balance. A \$35 fee is charged by the bank for anyfailed payments, and parents are responsible to pay this fee.

Q: I am going overseas for a vacation. Will you still charge my monthly fee?

A: Yes, as long as your child is occupying the spot, you are responsible for the fee. If you withdraw the student, you will not be charged. However once withdrawn, you can not re-enroll for six months, and subject to new registration fees as well.

Q: Can I get credit for extended absence?

A: You must get pre-approved and absence should be more than 3 months. Otherwise you are responsible for monthly fees during the absence.

Q: Can I deduct my monthly fees from the taxes?

A: Fees paid are in exchange for the services you receive, and hence it is not allowed by IRS to be considered deductible. We can however provide yearly receipt upon request.

Q: I just want to register for summer months. Can I do it?

A: No. Summer spots will be opened in first week of June, based on vacancy.

Q: What if I want to enroll my child for all six days?

A: Yes, you can. The applicable fee is: weekday session fee plus \$10 per child. HIFZ class is already a six days per week class and no additional fee is required.

Q: I don't have much income. Can I get tuition discout?

A: Yes, we will insha Allah provide need-based relief. You must bring your proof of income.

(Latest tax return, pay slip, employment letter etc.)

Q: Can I get credit for volunteer hours for my high school report?

A: Yes, fill out the volunteer registration form, and we will certify your hours served.

Q: Who can volunteer?

A: We need volunteers for in-class and admin duties. Brothers and sisters ages 13+ are welcome. Please fill out the volunteer registration form, and we will let you know how you can help.
